## Wednesday, February 11: Puerto Plata → Tortola (351NM) → Virgin Gorda

We will fly to Tortula in the British Virgin Islands. We will transfer by ferry to Virgin Gorda and our home for the next three nights, Biras Creek Resort. This private, romantic resort stands at the northern end of Virgin Gorda like a hilltop fortress, flanked by the sea on three sides.

This portion of the island is situated around North Sound with half a dozen other islands thus forming an almost land locked oasis for water sports and island exploring. Sir Francis Drake spent a few days in 1595 collecting his fleet in the North Sound before joining the legendary Sir John Hawkins for their unsuccessful attack on Puerto Rico.

# Terms & Conditions

## Our land program includes:

- All accommodations in hotels listed or similar categories based on double occupancy. *NOTE: When available, rooms may be upgraded to deluxe oceanfront or a junior suite for an additional cost.*
- All meals as specified in itinerary
- All sightseeing, hotel taxes, gratuities and guide services as in indicated in itinerary
- All entrance fees in museum and other activities listed in the itinerary
- All transfers from hotel to airport
- A full time Air Journey escort

## Our land program does not include:

- Travel Insurance. (available, call us for details)
- Airport departure taxes
- Cost of obtaining passport or visas and or inoculations
- Lunch boxes on flight day
- Beverages
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.

Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with a minimum participation of 7 airplanes.

## The Registration fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft
- 2009 Bahamas and Caribbean Pilot Guide, VFR charts, IFR low or high en route (based on aircraft type and pilot's preferences)
- Flight bag and collared, cotton shirt for the pilot with his name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. Additional shirts are available for passengers and crew at an additional cost.

## Cancellation, refunds:

- a) **Cancellation by the client:** Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:
- i) Given outside of 30 days of departure: AJ retains only the plane registration fee
  - ii) Between 30 and 15 days of departure: AJ retains 50% of the tour cost
  - iii) Between 14 and 5 days of departure: AJ retains 75% of the tour cost
  - iv) 4 days or less or No show of departure: AJ retains 100% of the tour cost
- b) **Cancellation by AJ:** Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action), they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.
