

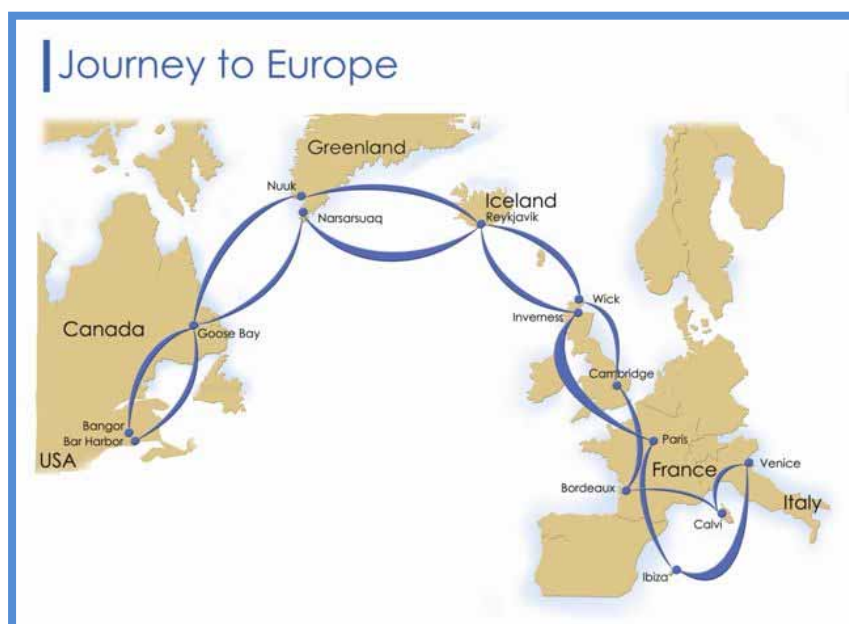


TRANS NORTH ATLANTIC JOURNEY

Dates: From Monday, September 6th to Friday, October 1st, 2010

Duration: 26 days / 25 nights

Total Distance: 9,300 nautical miles



Highlights: For many adventurous pilots, crossing the North Atlantic is a lifetime dream. Air Journey brings its experience to help motivated pilots and guests realize this dream.

This unique and spectacular North Atlantic crossing will take us through SIX time zones and to SEVEN different countries. We will discover different cultures, languages and... Yes, flight rules! We'll visit historical sights and enjoy gastronomical delights.

We will have plenty of time for both relaxation and discovery on this delightful escapade to Canada, Greenland, Iceland, Scotland, France (Paris, Bordeaux and Corsica), Italy (Venice) and Spain (Ibiza).

Itinerary

Day 1 - Monday, September 6: Bar Harbor, Maine

Air Journey will welcome you when all participants meet for introductions and to attend a very detailed briefing and flight safety demonstration. We'll cover the route, regulations, flight plan, safety, etc.

An optional dinner will be offered at the Harborside Hotel dining room, "La Bella Vita".

Day 2 - Tuesday, September 7: Bar Harbor, Maine → Goose Bay, Canada (617 NM)

On our way today we will fly over the immense forests and numerous lakes of Labrador. Because we will be approaching the Arctic Circle and the "land of the midnight sun", we will have an astonishing 17 hours of daylight!

Day 3 - Wednesday, September 8: Goose Bay → Iqaluit (675 NM) → Narsarsuaq, Greenland (674 NM)



Our flight today takes us to Southern Greenland where we will view the beautiful scenery before landing at Narsarsuaq airport. The airport was built by the US Air Force during World War II as a stopping-off point for planes flying to and from Europe and has been operated as an international civil airport since 1959.

There will be a stop in Iqaluit for lunch and to refuel.

Day 4 - Thursday, September 9: Narsarsuaq → Reykjavik, Iceland (667 NM)

After breakfast and our regular briefing, we will leave for Reykjavik, flying over ice-covered Greenland and then do our second water crossing. Tonight we will have dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 5 - Friday, September 10: Reykjavik

Today we will enjoy a full day of sightseeing where you will witness Iceland's most exciting natural attractions: the magnificent Gullfoss Waterfall, the volcanic crater Kerid, the greenhouse village Hveragerdi, across Gjabakkavegur Pass to the Thingvellir National Park – a unique place of beauty with its interesting geology and history.

Dinner will be at Einar Ben located downtown in one of the oldest trading buildings in Reykjavik.

Day 6 - Saturday, September 11: Reykjavik → Inverness, Scotland (652 NM)

We'll have a briefing before we fly southeast toward the British Isles for our next stop in Inverness, Scotland where we will stay at the Bunchrew House. This fine Scottish mansion situated on the shores of Beauly Firth is the ancestral home of both the Fraser and the McKenzie clans. The house dates from 1621 and is set on 8 hectares (20 acres) of landscaped gardens. You get a glimpse of a bygone era while relaxing in the paneled drawing room with roaring log fires.

Day 23 - Tuesday, September 28: Cambridge

Today it has one of the finest collections of tanks, military vehicles and naval exhibits in the country.

After breakfast and another in-depth briefing, we will head for Goose Bay (or Iqaluit) with a stop in Nuuk (or Kangerlussuaq) for lunch and to refuel before taking our final over-water crossing and touching down on the North American continent in Canada.

Terms & Conditions

Our land program includes:

- All accommodations in hotels listed or similar categories based on double occupancy
- All meals as specified in itinerary
- All sightseeing, hotel taxes, gratuities and guide services as in indicated in itinerary
- All entrance fees in museum and other activities listed in the itinerary
- All transfers from hotel to airport
- A full time Air Journey escort

Our land program does not include:

- Travel Insurance (Travel insurance is high recommended. Call Air Journey (561-841-1551) for details.)
- Airport departure taxes
- Beverages
- Cost of obtaining passport or visas and or inoculations
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals

Conditions:

- Valid passport is a must.
- No vaccinations or visas are required for this tour.
- Dry suits are mandatory and can be rented with the assistance of Air Journey.

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.

Our quoted prices include planning, handling and operational charges; they are based on current rates of exchange, tariffs and taxes as of April 2010. Air Journey reserves the right to increase tour prices to cover increased costs, tariffs and taxes, and to reflect fluctuations in foreign exchange markets.

Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with a minimum participation of 6 airplanes

The Registration fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft;
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf;
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight;
- Weather website with constant updates showing TAF, METAR, Wind Aloft, prognostic forecast and review;
- Fuel availability confirmed along the route of flight;
- VFR charts, IFR low or high en route (based on aircraft type and pilot's preferences);
- Flight bag and collared, cotton shirt for the pilot with his name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. Shirts are available for passengers and crew at an additional cost.

Cancellation, refunds:

- a) **Cancellation by the client:** Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:
- i) Given outside of 60 days of departure: Air Journey retains the plane registration fee
 - ii) Between 60 and 30 days of departure: Air Journey retains 20% of the tour cost
 - iii) Between 29 and 15 days of departure: Air Journey retains 50% of the tour cost
 - iv) Between 14 and 5 days of departure: Air Journey retains 75% of the tour cost
 - v) 4 days or less or No show of departure: Air Journey retains 100% of the tour cost
- b) **Cancellation by AJ:** Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action), they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis and will be waiting for you at our departure point. Contact us for details. Life vests and life raft are mandatory.
