



Bahamas Treasure Hunt Fall 2010

Dates: From Sunday, November 7th – Saturday, November 13th, 2010

Duration: 7 days / 6 nights

Itinerary

Day 1 - Sunday, November 7: Palm Beach North County → Treasure Cay, Abacos (155 NM)

Meet with Air Journey this morning at the North Palm Beach County Airport (F45) at the Landmark Aviation FBO. Refuel, collect your forms, survival gear (if needed), attend briefing (weather and to hear the latest details of the Treasure Hunt and how to collect clues).

Our flight takes us to Treasure Cay in the Abacos where we will transfer by ferry to the Green Turtle Club Resort on Green Turtle Cay.

The afternoon is at leisure. Fish or sail, snorkel or dive in the turquoise gin clear waters or just unwind, relax and recharge on the beach or by the pool. Explore remote islands, beaches and secret coves of 17th century Caribbean pirates or visit quaint 18th century fishing villages first settled during the Revolutionary War by Loyalists who fled to Abaco and the other islands of the Bahamas.

We'll meet for a welcome cocktail before dinner.

Day 2 - Monday, November 8: Green Turtle Cay

Today is at leisure to relax or explore on your own.

Optional activities include a visit the historic settlement of New Plymouth, a quiet 18th century village by the sea, with its museums, sculpture garden, shops, restaurants and pastel-painted clapboard-covered gingerbread homes that remind one of a turn-of-the-century village of the New England coast. Or grab your snorkel gear and explore the pristine world class reefs just off the Ocean Beach or scuba and discover the many offshore wrecks and caverns. The Dive Center is located adjacent to Green Turtle Club Resort and Marina complex and offers all level of instruction as well as certification, day trips, and dolphin encounters. For the fishermen, bone fishing in the Abacos is a popular activity. Fishing the reefs for grouper and snapper are fun for all anglers.

Day 3 - Tuesday, November 9: Treasure Cay → North Eleuthera (85 NM) → Rock Sound, Eleuthera (45 NM)

Today we depart for Eleuthera (Rock Sound). There will be an optional stop at North Eleuthera for lunch at Harbour Island overlooking the infamous beautiful pink sand beach.

Upon arrival in Eleuthera, we will transfer to the Cape Eleuthera Resort where we will stay in luxury two-story waterfront townhomes overlooking Rock Sound. Enjoy the glassy blue waters, pristine natural surroundings and charming Bahamian hospitality.

There are plenty of optional activities to choose from if you don't want to lie on the beach or plunge in the pool. Kayaking, snorkeling, boating and fishing are just a few of the options available while on the property.

Terms & Conditions

Our land program includes:

- All accommodations in hotels listed or similar categories based on double occupancy
- All meals as specified in itinerary
- A welcome cocktail at Green Turtle Club
- All sightseeing, hotel taxes, gratuities and guide services as in indicated in itinerary
- All entrance fees in museum and other activities listed in the itinerary
- All transfers from hotel to airport
- A full time Air Journey escort

Our land program does not include:

- Travel Insurance (available, call us for details)
- Airport departure taxes
- Beverages
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.

Passports are mandatory for the Journey.

Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with a minimum participation of 7 airplanes.

The Registration fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight
- Weather website with constant updates showing TAF, METAR, Wind Aloft, prognostic forecast and review
- Fuel availability confirmed along the route of flight
- 2010 Bahamas and Caribbean Pilot Guide, VFR charts, IFR low or high en route (based on aircraft type and pilot's preferences)
- Flight bag and collared, cotton shirt for the pilot with his name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. Additional shirts are available for passengers and crew at an additional cost.

Cancellation, refunds:

- a) **Cancellation by the client:** Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:
 - i) Given outside of 30 days of departure: AJ retains the initial deposit of \$350 per person
 - ii) Between 30 and 15 days of departure: AJ retains 50% of the tour cost
 - iii) Between 14 and 5 days of departure: AJ retains 75% of the tour cost
 - iv) 4 days or less or No show of departure: AJ retains 100% of the tour cost
- b) **Cancellation by AJ:** Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action), they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.
