Post Sun'n Fun Fly-Out to the Bahamas Green Turtle Cay – Treasure Cay

Dates: Sunday, April 18th – Wednesday, April 21st, 2010

Duration: 4 days / 3 nights

Itinerary

Day 1 - Sunday, April 18: Fort Pierce → Freeport, Grand Bahama (105 NM)

We will meet at St. Lucie County Airport (KFPR) at the Volo Aviation FBO for a 10:00am briefing on the forthcoming flight. We recommend that you arrive a little early to refuel and collect your completed forms and survival gear.

Upon arrival in Freeport, we will transfer to the Lucaya Reef Village. The resort faces 7.5 acres of soft, white sand beach, winding along the sparkling turquoise waters of the gentle Bahamian coast. The afternoon is at leisure to enjoy the property.



For recreation, the Sugar Mill Pool has a 60-foot stone tower, a spiral waterslide, and a quiet section next to a 10-person spa tub. Join in a volleyball game on the beach. Snorkeling and scuba diving equipment and lessons are offered at the resort's Water Sports Center. The Center can also arrange windsurfing, parasailing, banana boating, jet skiing, boating, sailing, fishing, and other "water-ful" adventures. The sparkling ocean surface hides an underwater world resplendent with life. Coral reefs attract marlin, sailfish, tuna, mahi-mahi, bonefish and mackerel.

In the late afternoon there will be a one hour seminar on eAPIS and documentation required to file for flights to and from the Bahamas.

We will end the day with a Welcome Cocktail. Dinner is on your own.

Day 2 - Monday, April 19: Freeport → Treasure Cay, Abaco Islands (70 NM)

After breakfast at the hotel, there will be a briefing with the journey director. Then we'll transfer back to the airport for our flight to Treasure Cay in the Abacos.

Upon arrival at Treasure Cay, we will transfer by ferry to the Green Turtle Club Resort on Green Turtle Cay.

The afternoon is at leisure. Fish or sail, snorkel or dive in the turquoise gin clear waters or just unwind, relax and recharge on the beach or by the pool. Explore remote islands, beaches and secret coves of 17th century Caribbean pirates or visit quaint 18th century fishing villages first settled during the Revolutionary War by Loyalists who fled to Abaco and the other Islands of The Bahamas.

Day 3 - Tuesday, April 20: Green Turtle Cay

Optional activities include a visit the historic settlement of New Plymouth, a quiet 18th century village by the sea, with its museums, sculpture garden, shops, restaurants and pastel-painted clapboard-covered gingerbread homes that remind one of a turn-of-the-century village of the New England coast. Or grab your snorkel gear and explore the pristine world class reefs just off the Ocean Beach or scuba and discover the many offshore wrecks and caverns. The Dive Center is located adjacent to Green Turtle Club Resort and Marina complex and offers all level of instruction as well as certification, day trips, and dolphin encounters. For the fishermen, bonefishing in the Abacos is a popular activity. Fishing the reefs for grouper and snapper are fun for all anglers.

Cancellation, refunds:

- a) **Cancellation by the client:** Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:
 - i) Given outside of 30 days of departure: AJ retains only the \$350 per person reservation fee
 - ii) Between 30 and 15 days of departure: AJ retains 50% of the tour cost
 - iii) Between 14 and 5 days of departure: AJ retains 75% of the tour cost
 - iv) 4 days or less or No show of departure: AJ retains 100% of the tour cost
- b) **Cancellation by AJ:** Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action), they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis and will be waiting for you at our departure point. Contact us for details. Life vests and survival raft are mandatory.
