#### DAY 2 - THURSDAY, MAY 25




# Quebec City, Canada (CYQB) → Kuujjuaq, Canada (CYVP) → Kangerlussuaq, Greenland (BGSF)

Fly over the immense forests and numerous lakes of Canada on our way to Kuujjuaq for a technical stop. Then continue over southern Greenland's beautiful scenery before landing at Kangerlussuaq in western Greenland.

The airport's Kangerlussuaq Museum illustrates the town's past as a U.S. airbase during WWII.

Because we will be approaching the Arctic Circle and the "land of the midnight sun", we will have an astonishing 20 hours of daylight!



# DAY 3 - FRIDAY, MAY 26



# Kangerlussuaq, Greenland (BGSF) → Reykjavik, Iceland (BIRK)

Continue our flight over ice-covered Greenland for our second leg of the Trans-Atlantic water crossing to Iceland.

Upon arrival, we will transfer to the Hotel Borg where we will enjoy luxury accommodations in the very center of Reykjavik.

The Hotel Borg overlooks the beautiful square of Austurvollur, and is situated across from Althingi, the Icelandic parliament and the cathedral.













# DAY 4 - SATURDAY, MAY 27

# Reykjavik, Iceland

Destination of the day is Porsmork - the "Woods of Thor the Thundergod". Guarding Porsmork nature reserve from unwanted traffic are several streams and glacial rivers cutting the rough track. Crossing requires caution but is a breeze in a Super Jeep. We will visit powerfully beautiful Seljalandsfoss waterfall, a good 60 meters of constant rush. Conditions permitting, how about a walk around it - yes, you can go behind Seljalandsfoss. Soon after the road starts disintegrating and nature takes over your senses.

Bordering Porsmork nature reserve to the south is the famously ash-spewing volcano Eyjafjallajokull, topped by glacial ice and snow. Amongst numerous places of interest on our route is the Gigjokull glacier lagoon which is actually off the maps now. In 2010 it disappeared under volcanic rubble in a catastrophic flood of glacial melt and debris, caused by the Eyjafjallajokull eruption.

# Reykjavik, Iceland (BIRK) → Stockholm, Sweden (ESSA)

We will leave Oslo behind as we fly to Stochholm, the capital city of Sweden as well as the largest urban area in Scandinavia. Rich in history and tradition, the more than 130 year old Grand Hotel Stockholm occupies a prime position on the city's waterfront overlooking the Royal Palace and Gamla Stan, Stockholm's old town, a timeless classic that has played a pivotal role in shaping Stockholm as the cosmopolitan city that it is today. The hotel has borne witness to some of the world's greatest achievements. Since 1901, the Nobel Prize laureates and their families have all been guests of the Grand Hotel Stockholm and the list of royalty, heads of state and artists who have stayed is impressive.






# DAY 9 - THURSDAY, JUNE 1

Today, we will depart for a full day tour to discover the highlights of this beautiful city.






# **DAY 14 - TUESDAY, JUNE 6**














# DAY 15 WEDNESDAY, JUNE 7



This morning we will discover the main attractions in Jaipur. Photo stop at Hawa Mahal - known as the "Palace of the Winds".

This beautiful facade is probably the most-photographed in Jaipur, with ornately carved windows designed so the ladies of the palace could look out onto the streets unobserved. It is considered as the finest example of Rajput architecture whose lattice like exterior of sandstone and stained glass is one of the area's most eyecatching icons.

We will continue to the 16th century Amber Fort. Tour the chambers and hallways of the palace. Within the complex is Ganesh Pol, an imposing gateway painted with the images of the elephant-headed god, Ganesh.

The merging of Rajput and Mughal architectural styles is visible throughout including within the Charbagh garden with its perfectly proportioned landscaping.



# DAY 21 - TUESDAY, JUNE 13

#### Jaipur, India

This morning, our visit takes us to the Jantar Mantar Observatory. Built in the 1700s but still appears to be futuristic. It houses unique instruments for measuring the harmony of the heavens! We will then continue to the City Palace to witness the Maharaja's private collection of textiles and armory.

This afternoon will have us visiting the Gyan Museum to view Indian jewelry. Over 2500 artifacts include textiles, Mughal rugs, silver hookahs, gemstones, jewelry, etc.

Experienced local trackers are rangers who have spent their entire lives in this forest. Weaving through the overhanging vines, mosscovered hagenia and giant lobelias that thrive in the tropical climate, the rangers soon bring us up close with a Gorilla family. Spend a magical hour with the group as they go about their daily life, feeding, playing, resting; raising their young.

Spend the afternoon searching the lush vegetation at the foot of Mount Sabyinyo for one of two habituated groups of golden monkey, one of them a troop of more than 80 members.






The many treasures unearthed at the Minoan palace sites are in the exceptional collection of the Archaeological Museum.









After our landing, we will transfer to Hotel Dukes' Palace. This property is the former residence of the Burgundian aristocracy. It is a very unique hotel in Flanders, located in the heart of the UNESCO World Heritage city of Bruges.



#### DAY 60 - SATURDAY, JULY 22

#### Ostend, Belgium

Today, we will enjoy a walking tour with our local guide as we begin our exploration of Bruges. We will visit the famous Minnewater (Lake of Love), one of the most delightful corners of the city. Next, we will explore the Lady's Church - home to Michelangelo's magnificent 16th-century marble statue, Madonna of Brugge – and the Market Square with its grand Belfry.

Our tour continues to the center of Bruges where we will admire Bruges' beautiful Town Hall Square (Burg) and the ornate façade of the Basilica of the Holy Blood. The basilica was originally constructed in the 12th century as the residence of the Count of Flanders. After lunch we will visit the Groeninge Museum ('The city museum of Fine Arts'). The collection in the museum spans several centuries (from the 14th to the 20th century) and focuses primarily on works by painters who lived and worked in Brugge.
