DAY 1: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 05

HOME → QUEBEC CITY, CANADA (CYQB)

Fly to Quebec City and enjoy this lovely town full of history and culture. We will meet at the beautiful Fairmont Le Chateau Frontenac.

In the late afternoon, there will be a briefing on the Journey including the first leg which will take us over Quebec to Kangerlussuaq. Gather in the hotel bar for a welcome cocktail before dinner.

DAY 2: THURSDAY, JUNE 06

🗲 785 + 725 NM

QUEBEC CITY, CANADA (CYQB) \rightarrow KUUJJUAQ, CANADA (CYVP) \rightarrow KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND (BGSF)

Fly over the immense forests and numerous lakes of Canada on our way to Kuujjuaq for a technical stop. Then, continue over southern Greenland's beautiful scenery before landing at Kangerlussuaq in western Greenland.

The airport's Kangerlussuaq Museum illustrates the town's past as a U.S. airbase during WWII.

Because we will be approaching the Arctic Circle and the "land of the midnight sun", we will have an astonishing 20 hours of daylight!

DAY 3: FRIDAY, JUNE 07

Commercial Flight

KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND → ILULISSAT, GREENLAND

Today we will take a commercial flight to Ilulissat, Greenland (not included).

Located about 150 miles north of the Arctic Circle, Ilulissat is the most accessible place to see both massive icebergs and the polar icecap. The town has a beautiful location at the mouth of the 35 mile long ice fjord that is filled with enormous icebergs from the most productive glacier in the northern hemisphere, Sermeq Kujalleq. The Ice Fjord surrounds Ilulissat with gigantic formations of icebergs, calving glaciers, and isolated settlements. It offers breathtaking Arctic experiences all year round.

Experience the Midnight Sun illuminating the ice until late into the night.

DAY 4: SATURDAY, JUNE 08

ILULISSAT, GREENLAND

We will enjoy a Glacier & Iceberg Cruise sailing past a fascinating variety of floes and icebergs. The Ice Fjord, which is close to Hotel Arctic, was included on UNESCO's World Heritage List at the 28th of The World Heritage Committee in the summer of 2004.


On a clear day, the landscape is truly surreal. Hundreds of icebergs surround Ilulissat. They vary in shape from flattopped hunks to jagged mountain peaks, and in size from small doghouses to mega-cruise ships and larger and that's just the part above the surface!

The Ice Fjord contains one of the biggest and most active glaciers in the world. Its 3,000 square kilometer area advances at a rate of 20 meters per day. The glacier "calves" about 10 % of the inland ice that is pressed out into the sea from Greenland and there is nothing in the whole world that resembles it.

DAY 5: SUNDAY, JUNE 09

ILULISSAT, GREENLAND

Today is at leisure to relax or explore on your own. Your journey director will be available to help you plan your day.



DAY 6: MONDAY, JUNE 10 🛩 Commercial Flight + 750 NM

ILULISSAT, GREENLAND → KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND (BGSF) → REYKJAVIK, ICELAND (BIRK)

After breakfast, we will take a commercial flight back to Kangerlussuaq to retrieve our airplanes and fly to Reykjavik, Iceland. Upon arrival we will transfer to the Hotel Borg.

Enjoy luxury accommodations in the very center of Reykjavik. The Hotel Borg overlooks the beautiful square of Austurvollur and is situated across from Althingi, the Icelandic parliament and the cathedral.

DAY 7: TUESDAY, JUNE 11

This afternoon, we will visit the Blue Lagoon, Iceland's most unique and popular attraction. Communicating a world of healing power, wellness and beauty, the Blue Lagoon was founded on a unique source of geothermal seawater that originates in Iceland's extreme environment.

DAY 8: WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12

REYKJAVIK, ICELAND \rightarrow SELFOSS, ICELAND

Golden Circle and the Langjokull Glacier

Enjoy an incredible Super Jeep tour where you will witness Iceland's most exciting natural attractions.

First, we will visit Thingvellir National Park – a unique place of beauty with its interesting geology and history. Then, we will head eastbound on the mountain road to Lyngdalshei to view the lava fields on the hills above Laugarvatn.

At Haukadalur, see the famous Strokkur geyser erupting and spewing boiling water into the air. We will spend some time here observing the eruptions and exploring the hot springs before heading up to the magnificent Gullfoss waterfall cascading into the white Hvita River along with glacial water.

We finish our tour with our arrival at the Hotel Ion - perfectly located to enjoy all the activities and adventures South Iceland has to offer.













DAY 9: THURSDAY, JUNE 13

SELFOSS, ICELAND

For a truly unique experience, you will get the opportunity of a life time to enjoy one of the world's greatest wilderness; Iceland's second largest glacier - from the inside!

Never before the Langjokull ice tunnels has anyone been able to see the beautiful blue ice at the heart of an ice cap glacier.

You will get to drive in a specially modified snow truck on the glacier, explore the glacier environment, enjoy a view out of this world and go INTO the glacier to experience the glacier's beauty from the inside!

DAY 10: FRIDAY, JUNE 14

SELFOSS, ICELAND → REYKJAVIK, ICELAND (BIRK) → KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND (BGSF) → GOOSE BAY, CANADA (CYYR) → BURLINGTON, VERMONT, US (KBTV)

Today we will take a ground transfer back to Reykjavik to retrieve our airplanes and fly to Burlington, Vermont. There will be two technical stops before landing in the US: the first one will be in Kangerlussuaq, Greenland, and the next one will be in Goose Bay Canada.

Upon arrival, we will transfer to the Hilton Burlington where we will enjoy an overnight stay to prepare ourselves for our flight to come back home.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Our land program includes:

- Presence of an Air Journey tour leader who will facilitate clearances, Immigration, refueling, flight planning, and provide help with any difficulty that might arise

- Full-time services of a professional Air Journey guide and local experts

- Lodging: for 11 days, 10 nights

- Meals as described in the program

- Wine selected by Air journey is included with dinner. All other beverages are not included.

- Tours and admission to all planned group sightseeing as listed in the itinerary

- All service charges and taxes
- Round trip transfers between airport and hotel

Our land program does not include:

- Airport departure taxes.
- Fees associated with the airports and aircraft.
- Fuel for the aircraft.
- Cost of obtaining passport or visas and or inoculations
- Beverages except as noted
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals
- Travel Insurance (Highly Recommended)

Journey Requirements

Passports & Visas

Passports are mandatory for the Journey and they must to be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Air Journey will closely monitor visa requirements and will provide you with all the information at least 120 days before the departure date.

Vaccinations

Air Journey will closely monitor vaccination requirements for each country in the itinerary, to ensure compliance with local heatlh regulations. All the information will be provided to you at least 120 days before the departure date.

Travel and Cancellation Insurance

Travel and Cancellation Insurance is strongly recommended and not included in the package, but it can be purchased from Air Journey. Contact Anais (561 841-1551) at Air Journey for a quote today. Birth dates and State of residence will be required.

Survival Equipment

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis and will be sent to you prior to the meeting at the departure point. Life vests and a transatlantic certified life raft are mandatory for all aircraft participating on the journey. If traveling with a single engine aircraft, dry suits per person on board is required as well. Contact us for more details.

The Airplane Registration Fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft.

- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf.

- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight.

- A fleece lined jacket, and a collared, cotton shirt for each traveling participant on the full Journey with their name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. A bag is provided for each couple.

Cancellation, refunds:

a) Cancellation by the client: Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:

Given outside of 90 days of departure:	AJ retains the deposit and will hold the Plane Registration Fee on credit for 12
	months from client cancellation date.
Between 90 and 60 days of departure:	AJ retains 50% of tour cost and plane registration fee
Between 60 and 45 days of departure:	AJ retains 75% of tour cost and plane registration fee
Less than 45 days or no show of departure:	AJ retains 100% of tour cost and plane registration fee

b) **Cancellation by AJ**: Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action, disease) they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.
