














DAY 4 | SATURDAY, JANUARY 27

PERUVIAN AMAZON CRUISE

The locals call Yacapana Islands "The Islands of the Iguana" because of the large number of these reptiles like tiny dinosaurs which inhabit them. Amazon folklore says that if you touch an iguana, you will develop some of its characteristics and, as no one wants to look like them, these animals are well protected.

We will also see the famous Amazon River dolphins, pink or gray, along our route. Amazonian people believe that these dolphins possess the power to turn into men and women of great beauty.

As you float down the Yarapa River, past the occasional fishermen paddling in their canoes, you will spot wildlife: terns, tropical songbirds, black collared hawks and sloth share this wonderful world with us.

Upon arrival at Lake Moringo, use your hooks to try to catch some of the ferocious piranhas and other fish species. As you fish, trained naturalist guides will tell the story of the lake and its inhabitants.

In the late afternoon we will sail on to Lake Clavero where villagers paddle in their traditional dugout canoes. You may wish to swim in the lake's calm waters and visit the community to interact with our Amazonia neighbors who will be pleased to welcome you.

DAY 5 | SUNDAY, JANUARY 28

PERUVIAN AMAZON CRUISE

This morning board the skiffs to explore a fascinating black water stream, part of the vast Amazon flooded forest within the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve.

Your guide will tell you about the jungle as you explore what scientists call a "gallery forest," because of its dense vegetation that creates a tunnel of leaves. As you explore this type of riparian vegetation, watch above for parrots, macaws, and fluffy monk saki monkeys.

In the late afternoon you will take a magical journey through the "Jungle of the Mirrors," where towering trees are reflected in the dark river.

Move on to Dorado River where you may observe enchanting parrots, macaws and a variety of primates, unperturbed by our presence. As you make your way back to the Aqua Nera, you may see alligators, frogs and fishing bats.

Fly to Cusco where we will transfer to Belmond Hotel Monasterio. Experience the thrill of staying in a protected national monument, while discover inspired restaurants and boutique rooms and suites, all clustered around a tranquil central courtyard.

DAY 8 | WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 31


CUSCO, PERU

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Our land program includes:

- Presence of a Journey Director who will facilitate clearances, Immigration, refueling, flight planning, and provide help with any difficulty that might arise.
- Local tour guide will be provided for full-day and half-day tours, when mentioned in the itinerary.
- Lodging: for 11 days, 10 nights
- All accommodations, meals and fully guided sightseeing as noted in the itinerary.
- Beverages will be included when meals are included. Wine selected by Air journey is included with dinner. Premium wines and spirits are not included.
- All service charges and taxes.
- Round trip transfers between airports and hotels.

Our land program does not include:

- Airport departure taxes.
- Fees associated with the airports and aircraft.
- Fuel for the aircraft.
- Cost of obtaining passport or visas and or inoculations
- Spirits and liquors are not included.
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals
- Travel Insurance (Highly Recommended)

Journey Requirements

Passports & Visas

Passports are mandatory for the Journey and they must to be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.

Air Journey will closely monitor visa requirements and will provide you with all the information at least 120 days before the departure date.

Vaccinations

Air Journey will closely monitor vaccination requirements for each country in the itinerary, to ensure compliance with local heatlh regulations. All the information will be provided to you at least 120 days before the departure date.

Travel and Cancellation Insurance

Travel and Cancellation Insurance is strongly recommended and not included in the package, but it can be purchased from Air Journey. Contact Anais (561 841-1551) at Air Journey for a guote today. Birth dates and State of residence will be required.

Survival Equipment

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis. Life vests are mandatory for all aircrafts participating on the journey. Life rafts are recommended. Contact us for more details.

The Airplane Registration Fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft.
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf.
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight.
- A collared, cotton shirt for each traveling participant on the full Journey with their name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. A bag is provided for each couple.

Cancellation, refunds:

a) Cancellation by the client: Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:

Given outside of 90 days of departure: Air Journey retains a \$5,000 deposit per person & will hold the plane registration fee on

credit for 12 months from client cancellation date.

Between 90 & 60 days of departure: Air Journey retains 50% of tour cost & will hold the plane registration fee on credit for 12

months from client cancellation date.

Between 60 & 45 days of departure: Air Journey retains 75% of tour cost & plane registration fee Less than 45 days or no show of departure: Air Journey retains 100% of tour cost & plane registration fee

b) Cancellation by AJ: Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action, disease) they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.
