


ULTIMATE CARIBBEAN JOURNEY

January 11 – 20, 2021



Itinerary

Day 1 - Monday, Jan 11: Stuart, Florida → Borinquen, Puerto Rico → Tortola, BVI to Virgin Gorda, BVI 890 + 150 NM

Air Journey, along with your Journey Director, will welcome you this morning to the Witham Field Airport Stuart Jet Center FBO located in Stuart, Florida (KSUA) for a pilot briefing prior to our forthcoming flight to the Caribbean.

After a quick technical stop in Borinquen, Puerto Rico, our Journey continues to Tortola, the largest of the British Virgin Islands in the Caribbean. Having gone through Customs, we will board a private boat transfer to make our way to Virgin Gorda, the third-largest Island in the BVI archipelago.

Virgin Gorda is home to the recently renovated Rosewood Little Dix Bay Resort. Their pristine, half-mile crescent beach, dubbed 'wilderness beach' is one of the world's finest. Staying true to its founder, Laurence Rockefeller, the resort maintains a sensible approach to luxury, co-existing in harmony with the island's natural and beautiful environment.

Day 2 - Tuesday, Jan 12: Virgin Gorda, BVI

Today we will set out on a private boat (weather permitting), sail by several of the seven secluded beaches on the island, one of which will be our destination. We will have the opportunity to snorkel and explore the unique colors under the sea in some of the most secluded spots of the archipelago and enjoy a private picnic lunch before heading back to our resort.

Day 4 - Thursday, Jan 14: Virgin Gorda, BVI to Tortola, BVI
➔ Canouan, St. Vincent & Grenadines 390 NM

After breakfast, we will board our private water transport to Tortola and take our short flight to Canouan. Located in St. Vincent & The Grenadines, Canouan Island is a remote island hideaway that is fast becoming one of the most sought-after luxury destinations in the world.

Upon arrival, we will transfer to the new Mandarin Oriental, Canouan.

Boasting a dreamy setting of glass-clear seas, powdery sand beaches and vibrant greenery, Mandarin Oriental, Canouan is an island gem with elegant colonial-style suites, Lagoon Villas and Italian-design Patio Villas.

A Fazio-designed Golf course and a luxury super – yacht marina are some of the island treasures that can be enjoyed with the Hotel’s legendary service.

With a balmy Caribbean climate, exquisite surroundings and fabulous facilities, Canouan redefines the idyllic tropical island getaway.

Day 5: Friday, Jan 15: Canouan, St. Vincent & Grenadines

Canouan is part of the Grenadines archipelago, which is made up of 32 islands and cays.

Today we will explore this fascinating area, spot sea turtles or see where scenes of 'Pirates of the Caribbean' were filmed on a half-day catamaran boat excursion.

Optional activities include snorkeling in Tobago Cays, visit Mustique, walk the beaches of Mayreau or a deep-sea fishing trip.

Day 7: Sunday, Jan 17: Canouan, St. Vincent & Grenadines

➔ **Antigua, West Indies**

After breakfast, we will transfer to the airport for our flight to Antigua. Once there, we will travel by private boat to our island home for the next three days, Jumby Bay. Situated on a private island two miles off the coast of Antigua, this exclusive, luxury resort is a naturalist's haven with its lush landscape, stately palm trees, and three superb, white sand beaches.

There will be a technical stop in Borinquen, Puerto Rico, to refuel and clear US customs. This technical stop allows you to continue north towards your final destination without the need to stop along Florida's coastline.

Terms and Conditions

Our land program includes:

- Presence of an Air Journey tour leader who will facilitate clearances, Immigration, refueling, flight planning, and provide help with any difficulty that might arise
- Accommodation based on double occupancy
- Meals as indicated in the itinerary
- Wine selected by Air journey is included with dinner. All other beverages are not included.
- Welcome cocktail
- Round trip transfers between airport and hotel
- Tours and admission to all planned group sightseeing
- All service charges and taxes
- Customs expediting
- Customs and Immigration forms (filled by Air Journey when possible)

Our land program does not include:

- Travel Insurance (available, call us for details)
- Airport departure taxes
- Beverages except as noted above
- Personal expenses such as laundry, communication charges and other incidentals

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.

Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with a minimum participation of 5 aircraft.

The Registration fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight
- Weather website with constant updates showing TAF, METAR, Wind Aloft, prognostic forecast and review
- Fuel availability confirmed along the route of flight
- Journey bag (one per couple) and collared, cotton shirt for the pilot with his name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. Additional shirts are available for passengers and crew at an additional cost.

Cancellation, refunds:

- a) **Cancellation by the client:** Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:
 - i) Given outside of 120 days of departure: AJ retains deposit and plane registration fee
 - ii) Between 120 and 91 days of departure: AJ retains 50% of tour cost and plane registration fee
 - iii) Between 90 and 61 days of departure: AJ retains 75% of tour cost and plane registration fee
 - iv) Less than 60 days or no show of departure: AJ retains 100% of tour cost and plane registration fee
- b) **Cancellation by AJ:** Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action), they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Valid Passports are mandatory for this Journey.

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis and can be arranged prior to your Journey. Life vests are mandatory. A life raft is recommended. Contact us for details
