





- Embark on a walking tour for an intimate and insider's view of the beautiful Amsterdam and experience a canal cruise on the river.




















#### DAY 1: SUNDAY, JUNE 04

#### HOME → QUEBEC CITY, CANADA (CYQB)

Welcome to Quebec City! Air Journey staff will greet you at the Fairmont Le Château Frontenac. Situated in the heart of historic Old Quebec, the hotel sits high on a bluff overlooking St. Lawrence River.

All participants will meet for introductions and attend an extensive briefing covering the general procedures of our journey as well as details for tomorrow's departure.

Afterwards, we will gather for a welcome cocktail before dinner.

#### DAY 2: MONDAY, JUNE 05

✓ 690 + 725 NM

QUEBEC CITY, CANADA (CYQB) + KUUJJUAQ, CANADA (CYVP) → KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND (BGSF)

We will fly over the immense forests and numerous lakes of Canada on our way to Kuujjuaq for a technical stop.

Then, continue over southern Greenland's beautiful scenery before landing at Kangerlussuaq in western Greenland. The airport's Kangerlussuaq Museum illustrates the town's past as a U.S. airbase during WWII.

Because we will be approaching the Arctic Circle and the "land of the midnight sun," we will have an astonishing 20 hours of daylight!

#### DAY 3: TUESDAY, JUNE 06

#### KANGERLUSSUAQ, GREENLAND (BGSF) → REYKJAVIK, ICELAND (BIRK)

Fly over ice-covered Greenland as we continue towards Iceland. Upon arrival, we'll transfer to the Hotel Borg where we will enjoy luxury accommodations in the very center of Reykjavik. The Hotel Borg overlooks the beautiful square of Austurvollur, and is situated across from Althingi, the Icelandic parliament and the cathedral.

After dinner at the hotel, you may want to venture on your own to experience the local nightlife.

#### DAY 4 | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 07

#### REYKJAVIK, ICELAND

Today, we will venture on an adventurous descent inside the remains of Iceland's dormant Thrihnukagigur volcano.

We will traverse the surreal landscapes of Iceland's countryside on our way to the Blue Mountains, hiking through the area's craggy lava fields. Then we will follow our guide inside the geological site's immense subterranean interior, its walls still scalded from an eruption that took place 4,000 years ago.


#### DAY 5 | THURSDAY, JUNE 08

REYKJAVIK, ICELAND (BIRK) → DEAUVILLE, FRANCE (LFRG) → NORMANDY, FRANCE

This morning, we continue north to Deauville, France, for our visit of Normandy. Upon landing, we will transfer to the Chateau de Canisy, the private and most unique chateau of Count Denis de Kergolay in Canisy.

Enjoy the lifestyle of French royalty in this privately-owned Normandy castle. Set on 800 acres of verdant Normandy countryside, in existence for over 1,000 years, the Chateau de Canisy is a historic presence of monumental proportions. Even more special still, is the fact that for those thousand years it has belonged to the same family, and it is their home.





#### DAY 6 | FRIDAY, JUNE 09

#### NORMANDY, FRANCE

We embark on a journey of discovery, visiting the sites of D-day (June 6, 1944) - the largest invasion force in history. Codenamed OVERLORD, it delivered five naval assault divisions to the beaches of of Normandy (codenames UTAH, OMAHA, GOLD, JUNO and SWORD).

We will walk among the cliffs, bunkers and edges, visit several museums, D-Day memorials and the very moving American Cemetery.









#### NORMANDY, FRANCE → DEAUVILLE, FRANCE (LFRG) → PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC (LKPR)

Fly to Czech Republic to discover the beautiful city of Prague. One of the most beautiful and visited cities of Europe, this capital of 1.2 million has an incredible mix of Gothic, Romanesque, Baroque and Art Nouveau architecture. The Vltava River winds through this "city of a hundred spires," its riverbanks and the surrounding hills contrasting with compact, winding cobblestone streets of the old city center.

At the crossroads of centuries-old trade routes and now the cultural and economic center of the Czech Republic, Prague is an art-filled jewel in the heart of Europe. Alive with music and culture, it offers elegant riverside promenades, breath-taking architecture and cafe-lined squares.

#### DAY 9 | MONDAY, JUNE 12

#### PRAGUE, CZECH REPUBLIC

Today, we will depart with a private local guide for a walking tour of Prague Castle and Lesser Town. The largest ancient castle in the world, Prague Castle sits on the highest hill in the city. Gigantic St. Vitus Cathedral, part of the castle, towers over the city and took 600 years to build. The crown-jewels of the Bohemian Kings and relics of St. Wenceslas, the 10th-century Duke of Bohemia, are on display.

We will explore the history and precious cultural and architectonic heritage of Prague. It is one of the most attractive sites in Europe and not only for its geographic location. It is called the "Heart of Europe", as it lies in the center of the Bohemia on the river.

#### DAY 15 | SUNDAY, JUNE 18


#### MENORCA, SPAIN



After breakfast, we will head west to return home. Two technical stops have been arranged in Kangerlussuaq, Greenland and then in Goose Bay, Canada for refueling before continuing onwards to Bangor, Maine, to clear US Customs. For those based on the west coast of the United States, an alternate stop to clear US customs can be arranged.

Afterwards, we will all go our separate ways home.

#### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### Our land program includes:

- Presence of an Air Journey tour leader who will facilitate clearances, Immigration, refueling, flight planning, and provide help with any difficulty that might arise
- Full-time services of a professional Air Journey guide and local experts
- Lodging: for 22 days, 21 nights
- Meals as described in the program
- Wine selected by Air journey is included with dinner. All other beverages are not included.
- Tours and admission to all planned group sightseeing as listed in the itinerary
- All service charges and taxes
- Round trip transfers between airport and hotel

#### Our land program does not include:

- Airport departure taxes.
- Fees associated with the airports and aircraft.
- Fuel for the aircraft.
- Cost of obtaining passport or visas and or inoculations
- Beverages except as noted
- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals
- Travel Insurance (Highly Recommended)

#### **Journey Requirements**

#### **Passports & Visas**

Passports are mandatory for the Journey and they must to be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date.

Air Journey will closely monitor visa requirements and will provide you with all the information at least 120 days before the departure date.

#### **Vaccinations**

Air Journey will closely monitor vaccination requirements for each country in the itinerary, to ensure compliance with local heatlh regulations. All the information will be provided to you at least 120 days before the departure date.

#### **Travel and Cancellation Insurance**

Travel and Cancellation Insurance is strongly recommended and not included in the package, but it can be purchased from Air Journey. Contact Anais (561 841-1551) at Air Journey for a quote today. Birth dates and State of residence will be required.

#### **Survival Equipment**

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis and will be sent to you prior to the meeting at the departure point. Life vests and a transatlantic certified life raft are mandatory for all aircraft participating on the journey. If traveling with a single engine aircraft, dry suits per person on board is required as well. Contact us for more details.

#### The Airplane Registration Fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft.
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf.
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight.
- A fleece lined jacket, and a collared, cotton shirt for each traveling participant on the full Journey with their name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. A bag is provided for each couple.

#### Cancellation, refunds:

a) Cancellation by the client: Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:

Given outside of 90 days of departure: AJ retains \$1,250 & will hold the plane registration fee on credit for 12 months, from the

client cancelation date.

Between 90 and 60 days of departure: AJ retains 50% of the tour cost & will hold the plane registration fee on credit for 12 months,

from the client cancelation date.

Between 60 and 45 days of departure: AJ retains 40% of tour cost & the plane registration fee. Less than 45 days or no show of departure: AJ retains 100% of tour cost & the plane registration fee.

b) Cancellation by AJ: Should AJ cancel the tour after deposits have been received due to fewer than the minimum participants required, the full deposit will be refunded. Should AJ cancel the tour at any time due to factors beyond their control (including war, flood, force of nature, riot, civil action, disease) they will refund the client whatever portion of moneys are reimbursed by ground operators and accommodation suppliers.

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued. Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with minimum participation of 5 airplanes. Our quoted prices are based on current rates of exchange, tariffs and taxes as of **September 2022**.
