

- In Manaus, encounter the magnificent pink dolphins, a fascinating species that inhabits the region.














STUART, FLORIDA (KSUA) + KINGSTON, JAMAICA (MKJP) → CARTAGENA, COLOMBIA (SKCG)

Fly to Colombia (there will be an optional technical stop in Ocho Rios, Jamaica) one of the most ethnically diverse nations in South America.

Cartagena, undeniably one of Latin America's most beautiful cities lost somewhere in time between the sixteenth and nineteenth centuries, with the Caribbean sea as a sparkling backdrop. Sir Francis Drake laid siege to the city but the fortress walls and cannons remain, making the area within the old walled city a living museum.



A visit to Monserrate Top (10,341' above sea level and accessible by cable car or funicular) provides a breathtaking view of the city below.



BOGOTA, COLOMBIA (SKBO) → IQUITOS, PERU (SPQT)

Fly to Iquitos situated on the banks of the Amazon River in the heart of the northern Peruvian Amazon region. Upon arrival, transfer to Iquitos Main Wharf where the Aquan Nera Cruise awaits you.

Over the next three days, you will sail along some of the largest tributaries of the Amazon, as well as the mighty Amazon itself. You will be embarking on a magnificent adventure to places visited by only a very few.

The 130-foot, M/V Aquan Nera is the ultimate luxury cruise ship on the northern Amazon River in Peru. Built in 2011 to the highest standards of modern small ship cruise lines, it is fully air conditioned throughout and all the suites on the Aquan Nera are comparable to a 5-star hotel with private baths, luxury toiletries and fine linen bedding to lull you to sleep under the stars of the Amazon.

From the gourmet Peruvian cuisine to the crystal and china service at dinner, the amenities onboard the Aquan Nera will treat you to an intimate but luxurious Amazon River cruise.

Three highly trained interpreter Amazon River guides will take you on as many as three expeditions a day, aboard comfortable motorized skiffs. They will give you both the big picture of life on the Amazon, and will point out the multitude of small details that make the region special - a howler monkey hidden in a tree, a vivid butterfly resting on a leaf, a bird, such as the endangered harpy eagle, enjoying the tranquility of the Amazon basin.

DAY 7 | SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 18

PERUVIAN AMAZON CRUISE

The locals call Yacapana Islands "The Islands of the Iguana" because of the large number of these reptiles like tiny dinosaurs which inhabit them. Amazon folklore says that if you touch an iguana, you will develop some of its characteristics and, as no one wants to look like them, these animals are well protected.

We will also see the famous Amazon River dolphins, pink or gray, along our route. Amazonian people believe that these dolphins possess the power to turn into men and women of great beauty.

As you float down the Yarapa River, past the occasional fishermen paddling in their canoes, you will spot wildlife: terns, tropical songbirds, black collared hawks and sloths share this wonderful world with us.

Upon arrival at Lake Moringo, use your hooks to try to catch some of the ferocious piranhas and other fish species. As you fish, trained naturalist guides will tell the story of the lake and its inhabitants.

In the late afternoon, we will sail on to Lake Clavero where villagers paddle in their traditional dugout canoes. You may wish to swim in the lake's calm waters and visit the community to interact with our Amazonia neighbors who will be pleased to welcome you.

DAY 8 | MONDAY, FEBRUARY 19

PERUVIAN AMAZON CRUISE

This morning board the skiffs to explore a fascinating black water stream, part of the vast Amazon flooded forest within the Pacaya Samiria National Reserve.

Your guide will tell you about the jungle as you explore what scientists call a "gallery forest," because of its dense vegetation that creates a tunnel of leaves. As you explore this type of riparian vegetation, watch above for parrots, macaws, and fluffy monk saki monkeys.

In the late afternoon you will take a magical journey through the "Jungle of the Mirrors," where towering trees are reflected in the dark river.

Move on to Dorado River where you may observe enchanting parrots, macaws and a variety of primates, unperturbed by our presence. As you make your way back to the Aquan Nera, you may see alligators, frogs and fishing bats.









DAY 9 | TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 20

DISEMBARK ARIA AMAZON CRUISE → IQUITOS, PERU (SPQT) → CUSCO, PERU (SPZO)

Fly to Cusco where we will transfer to Belmond Hotel Monasterio.

Experience the thrill of staying in a protected national monument, while discovering inspired restaurants, and boutique rooms and suites, all clustered around a tranquil central courtyard.

This is the ideal hotel from which to discover the delights of the city, its doors open to a vibrant scene of old and modern architecture, markets, galleries and cafes serving exciting Andean cuisine.

First guests will observe the sky with the naked eye and later discover amazing visualizations through one of the largest private telescopes in the area to observe planets like Mars and Saturn.

Built on the summit of a hill overlooking the San Pedro River, Pukara de Quitor is an ancient Indian fortress whose construction dates back to the XII century. It was declared a national monument in 1982.







We will then continue our tour to Punta del Este town and see the most important places and beaches.





Journey Requirements

Passports & Visas

Passports are mandatory for the Journey and they must to be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Air Journey will closely monitor visa requirements and will provide you with all the information at least 120 days before the departure date.

Vaccinations

Air Journey will closely monitor vaccination requirements for each country in the itinerary, to ensure compliance with local heatlh regulations. All the information will be provided to you at least 120 days before the departure date.

Travel and Cancellation Insurance

Survival Equipment

The Airplane Registration Fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft.

- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight.

Cancellation, refunds:

a) Cancellation by the client: Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:

Given outside of 120 days of departure: Air Journey retains \$5000 of tour cost & will hold the plane registration fee on credit

for 12 months, from the client cancellation date.

Between 120 and 60 days of departure: Air Journey retains 50% of tour cost & will hold the plane registration fee on credit
