**Dates:** Friday, May 25<sup>th</sup> – Monday, May 28<sup>th</sup>, 2012

# ITINERARY

## Day 1, Friday, May 25: North Palm Beach → North Eleuthera (200 NM) → New Bight, Cat Island (97 NM)

We will meet at North County Airport (F45) at the Landmark Aviation FBO for a briefing on the forthcoming flight. We recommend that you arrive a little early to refuel and collect your completed forms and survival gear.

Then we'll depart on our flight to North Eleuthera. Upon arrival, we will transfer to Harbour Island, visit this unique settlement and enjoy lunch (on own) on the beautiful pink sand beach.

After lunch and exploring the island, we will retrace our path, takeoff again, and fly down the island of Eleuthera to Cat Island.

We'll end the day with a welcome cocktail by the pool and dinner at the hotel.

### Our land program includes:

- Personal expenses such as laundry, room service, communication charges and other incidentals

Please note that hotel accommodations and sightseeing are subject to change due to unforeseen circumstances. Air Journey reserves the right to amend the order of sightseeing as necessary. Every effort will be made to operate tours as planned, but alterations may occur after the final itinerary has been issued.

### Passports are mandatory for the Journey.

Air Journey has quoted this itinerary with a minimum participation of 7 airplanes.

### The Registration fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight
- Weather website with constant updates showing TAF, METAR, Wind Aloft, prognostic forecast and review
- Fuel availability confirmed along the route of flight
- 2012 Bahamas and Caribbean Pilot Guide, VFR charts, IFR low or high en route (based on aircraft type and pilot's preferences)
- Flight bag and collared, cotton shirt for the pilot with his name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. Additional shirts are available for passengers and crew at an additional cost.

**Survival equipment** is available for rental on a daily basis and will be waiting for you at our departure point. Contact us for details. Life vests and survival raft are mandatory.
