The Vltava River winds through this "city of a hundred spires," its riverbanks and the surrounding hills contrasting with the compact, winding cobblestone streets of the old city center. Prague is lively and sophisticated, drawing on its centuries-old tradition of breakthrough thinking in literature, music, architecture and engineering.






Today, we will fly to Mary, Turkmenistan and explore the ancient town of Merv, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with a local archaeologist. There will be lunch at a local restaurant before returning to the Mary airport.

Our journey will then continue to Dushanbe, Tajikistan. Upon arrival, we will transfer to the Hyatt Regency Dushanbe, one of the first 5-star luxury destinations in the city conveniently located in the city center on the grounds of City Park, adjacent to Lake Javonon. This traditional town square is enveloped by mosques and madrasas lavishly adorned with stunning tiles and crowned by vibrant blue domes. 

Afterward, we will explore the Guri Amir Mausoleum to pay our respects at the tomb of Tamerlane. Our experience continues with visits to the Bibi Khanym Mosque and the bustling Siab Bazaar.

Later, we will transfer to Meros, a mulberry tree paper-making studio, to relish a traditional Uzbek open-air lunch and enjoy a captivating private performance by a local tightrope-walking family. In the evening, we will revisit Registan Square, which takes on a particularly enchanting aura at night.













DAY 23 | TUESDAY, JUNE 04



SAMARKAND, UZBEKISTAN (UTSS) → BUKHARA, **UZBEKISTAN (UTSB)**

Fly to Bukhara. On arrival, transfer to the Mercure Bukhara Old Town, a charming hotel that seamlessly blends heritage and modern comfort.

Later in the afternoon, we will explore Bukhara on a walking tour, starting at Lyab-i-Hauz Square, the heart of Old Bukhara. During our excursion, we will visit an ancient Zoroastrian temple, which has been transformed into a mosque and is known today as Magok-i-Attari. Afterward, we will meander through the renowned Bukhara Trading Domes. As we stroll through the trading domes, we will have the opportunity to step into the workshops of local artisans, including a sixth-generation blacksmith, a calligrapher, and a local jeweler, and become acquainted with their crafts.

DAY 24 | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 05

BUKHARA, UZBEKISTAN

Our exploration of Bukhara, celebrated as one of the most complete medieval cities in Central Asia, will continue. We'll begin with a visit to the Samanid Mausoleum and the Bolo Haouz Mosque, both dating from the 9th to 10th centuries. The mosque's impressive 39-foot-high iwan, a covered pillared portico, is a striking example of Central Asian architecture. Afterward, we'll explore the Ark Citadel, an ancient structure that served as the residence of Bukhara's rulers for over a millennium. Following lunch, we'll head to the renowned Kalyan Square, where we'll be awed by the impressive Kalyan Minaret, often referred to as the Tower of Death, along with the Kalyan Mosque and the Mir-i-Arab Madrasa.






DAY 31 | WEDNESDAY, JUNE 12

Fly to Olbia, Italy. Upon arrival we will transfer to Hotel Cala di Volpe. Overlooking one of the most beautiful bays of the Costa Smeralda, the Hotel Cala di Volpe was built to resemble an ancient fishing village, with porches, granite flooring, arches and stairs.

A wooden bridge plunges into the crystalline waters of the sea while the beach is surrounded by juniper and myrtle bushes. Typical Sardinian rocks span the bay, helping to create the unique atmosphere for one of the most beautiful landscapes in the Mediterranean. DAY 34 | SATURDAY, JUNE 15

COSTA SMERALDA, ITALY

Today we will enjoy an unforgettable full-day boat trip to the islands of the La Maddalena Archipelago. 



Journey Requirements

Passports & Visas

Passports are mandatory for the Journey and they must to be valid for at least six (6) months after the return date. Air Journey will closely monitor visa requirements and will provide you with all the information at least 120 days before the departure date.

Vaccinations

Air Journey will closely monitor vaccination requirements for each country on the itinerary, to ensure compliance with local heatlh regulations. All the information will be provided to you at least 120 days before the departure date.

Travel and Cancellation Insurance

Survival Equipment

Survival equipment is available for rental on a daily basis. Life vests and a transatlantic life rafts are mandatory for all aircraft participating on the journey. Survival suits are required for single engine aircrafts. Contact us for more details.

The Airplane Registration Fee includes:

- Extensive Navigation log (airports, route, frequencies, information of airspace, nav-aids, reporting points, international flight plan) tailored for each aircraft.
- Flight plans and eAPIS manifest (departure and arrival) filed on your behalf.
- Pilot briefing prior to each day's flight.
- A fleece lined jacket, and a collared, cotton shirt for each traveling participant on the full Journey with their name and aircraft tail number embroidered on the upper front. A bag is provided for each couple.

Cancellation, refunds:

a) Cancellation by the client: Is always required in writing and is subject to the following schedule of dates, whereby some or all moneys paid will be retained:

Given outside of 90 days of departure: AJ retains the deposit and will hold the Plane Registration Fee on credit for 12
